



Dear Commissioner Castañon,

The telecommunications industry will be deploying infrastructure that will bring 5th Generation (5G) technology to the District of Columbia via wireless telecommunication antennae and equipment (small cell). Verizon Wireless is seeking to locate and install its small cell wireless network in your neighborhood. As part of this initiative, Verizon Wireless will be applying for a Public Space Permit from the District Department of Transportation (DDOT). As part of the permit application process, Verizon Wireless is notifying SMD 1A06 of the first small cell facility requested to be installed in your single member district.

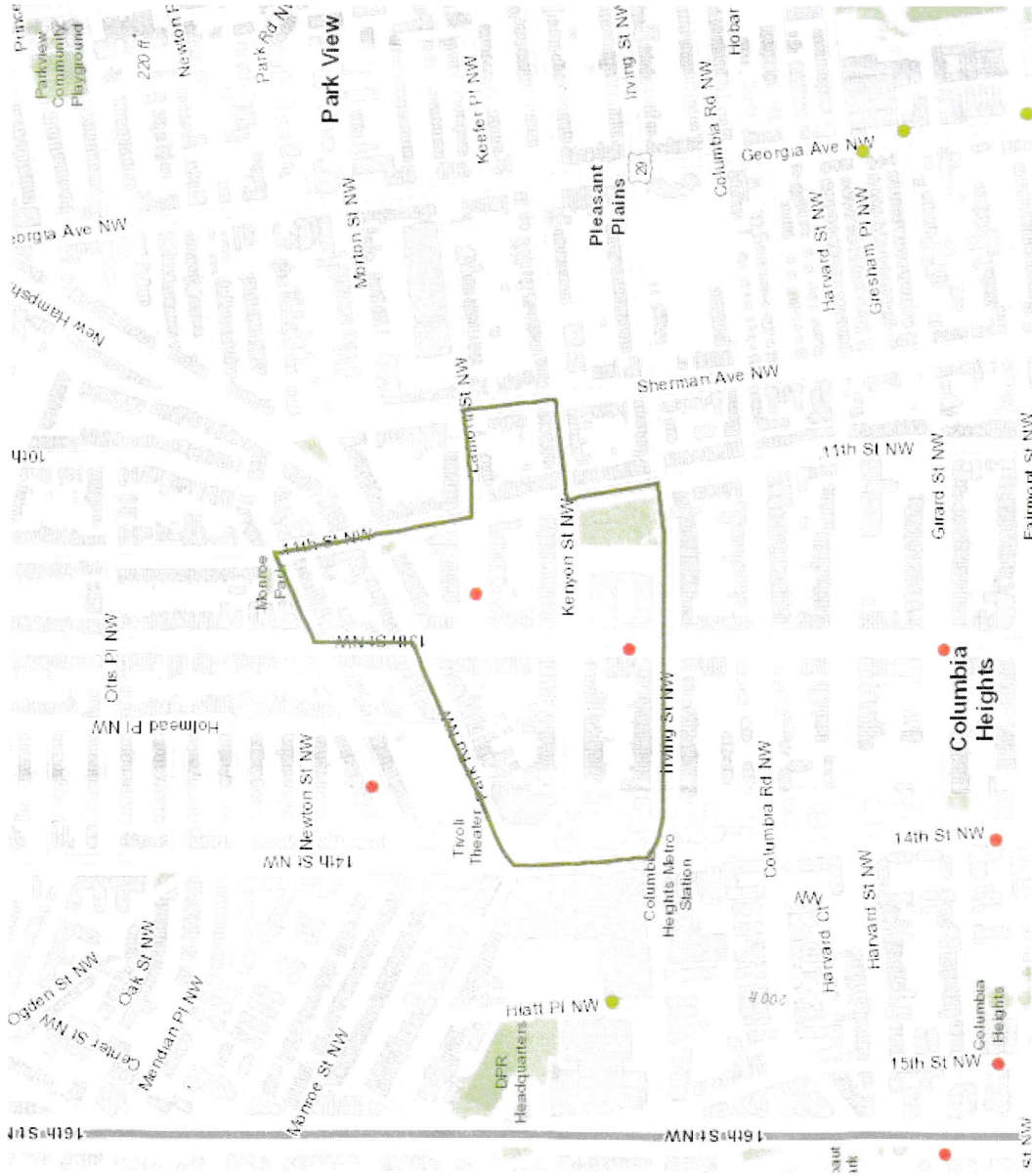
